JUNIOR AGE DIVISIONS

Ages 6 and under
7 & 8 years old
9 & 10 years old
11 & 12 years old
13 & 14 years old
15 & 16 years old

WEIGHT DIVISIONS

Light, medium, and heavy weight. Super light and super heavy if necessary.

SENIOR DIVISIONS (17 – 34)

Novice – Sankyu and below
Advanced – Nikyu and above

FEMALE: 48 kg, 52 kg, 57 kg, 63 kg, 70 kg, 78 kg, 78+ kg
MALE: 60 kg, 66 kg, 73 kg, 81 kg, 90 kg, 100 kg, 100 + kg

MASTERS DIVISIONS (35+)

Male & female, to be determined by the number of competitors.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE: I-40 to exit 27; follow Highway 23/74. Take exit 102 to 276 south. At the 2nd traffic light (Burger King/Rite Aid) turn Left onto Howell Mill Road. Turn Right on Vance Street. Waynesville Parks and Recreation will be on your left at 550 Vance Street, Waynesville, NC 28786.

REGISTRATION & WEIGH-IN: Weigh-in will begin Friday during Coaches Clinic (5p-7p) and will continue Saturday, October 5th 8:00 – 10:00 am
COMPETITION BEGINS at 11:00 am, Saturday, October 5th

HEAD REFEREE – Dana Rucker

ELIGIBILITY – Any current member of USJA, USJF, USA Judo, ATJA, or AJJF.

SCORING SYSTEM – Modified Double Elimination or Round Robin for divisions with 5 or less Judoka.

RULES – IJF rules will govern the competition with modification for no shime-waza below 13 years old and no kansetsu-waza below 17 years old.

COST -- \$55 for 1st division and \$20 for 2nd division. Competitors are only allowed to enter a maximum of 2 regular divisions – excluding the open division.

SPECIAL SENIOR OPEN DIVISION

If there is enough interest, then we will offer a special senior open division for \$20 per person. All contestants will be sorted by weight from lightest to heaviest. The competitors will be placed on a pool sheet and paired with the next competitor of the closest weight. Competition will continue in single elimination style until an eventual champion is crowned.

Individual awards will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each division.

- 1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.**

Agree that, prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
3. Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due to not only my own actions, inactions or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
- 4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability, or death.**
5. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue **United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, United States Judo, Inc., American Traditional Jujutsu Association, American Judo and Jujitsu Federation, United States Olympic Committee, Waynesville Kodokan Judo, Town of Waynesville N.C. and The Waynesville Park and Recreation**. Requirements:

Current USA Judo Membership and proof of rank, bring your proof.

Current background screening (SSCI \$16 fee if you don't have a current one) bring a copy or proof of completion.

Complete Coach Application to USA Judo,--your responsibility!

USA Judo Fee certification must be included, checks made to USA judo or enclosed credit information on your form.

Safesport Certification (www.safesport.org) must be attached

Concussion Training Certificate (www.cde.gov/concussion/HeadsUp/youth.html) must be attached

Passport type photo, if required
